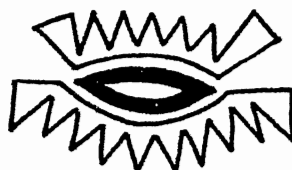

The Trolleyvox *Your Secret Safe/Luzerne* This is a bit of a cheat, as this double album came out in 2007, but I wasn't aware until early 2008. My most played album in '08 deserves some belated props I am hooked: Beth's vocals with Andrew's stellar songwriting that (at times) recall The Kinks, The Who, & The Beatles, etc. around '65-'67, just for a start. Lyrically intriguing, musically fascinating. One disc is power pop/rock & the other is "unplugged" intimacy & instrumentals. Both richly reward repeat listens.

Alejandro Escovedo - *Real Animal* The great Texas songster returns with a blazing set depicting his personal & musical legacy. Co-written by his pal & co-star Chuck Prophet, produced by the legendary Tony Visconti (Bowie/Thin Lizzy/T. Rex). This rollicking and vivacious disc ranks up there with his very best. Ample evidence was provided by the recent visit of his quartet to the High Noon Saloon.

Wye Oak - *If Children* The dynamic duo of Jenn and Andy captivated me right off. Forgive the cliché mash-up comparison, but this is sort of like if Cat Power went hunting for Fruit Bats at ol' Granddaddy's farm. It all adds up to an impressive debut. Sounds like a full band, but is just the duo with some overblubs. Another Merge Records winner. I am still kicking myself for missing their Madison show.

Ray Davies *Working Man's Cafe* The Kinks' main man refuses to fade away quietly (thankfully) as he continues to write and sing NEW classic songs 45 years after starting on this path. Topical yet timeless tunes by a songwriter who deserves so much more than the "also-ran old-guy" status he has been unfairly stuck with lately... Ray still has the fire & the desire, and you should give him some time

She & Him *Volume One* These two were lucky to find each other. Zoey Deschanel & M. Ward play to each other's strengths... Zoey wrote some tart mid-'60s-style pop tunes and Matt was willing to flesh them out with shny arrangements and accompaniment. 10 relationship songs (+ 2 covers) that should stand the test of time. Some may dismiss this as lightweight, but it has real resonance: she has great pipes. & is a fine songwriter. Their Barrymore Theatre show proved that this duo is the real deal.

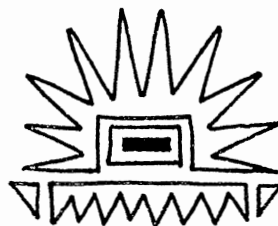
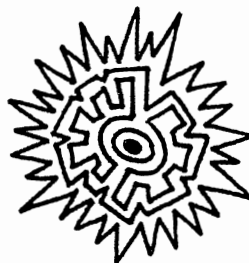
